GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

All Pure Super Algaecide is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using All Pure Super Algaecide. For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 6 fluid ounces of All Pure Super Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 11 fluid ounces of All Pure Super Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of All Pure Super Algaecide per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 0.6 fluid ounces of All Pure Super Algaecide per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.2 to 0.4 fluid ounces of All Pure Super Algaecide should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. All Pure Super Algaecide is compatible with chlorine chemicals normally required. However, do not mix All Pure Super Algaecide with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
