

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GILBERT'S DAIRY SUPPLEMENT is the rate of 100 parts per million per day for animals weighing between 400-2000 pounds. It is to be added to the dairy ration for dry cows in the grain or silage. Cattle weighing between 1200-1800 pounds should be fed 3 pounds per day.

Start feeding early in the spring before flies begin to appear and continue feeding through the summer and into the fall until cold weather restricts fly activity.

GILBERT'S DAIRY SUPPLEMENT can be fed to dry cows, replacement animals and lactating cows.

GILBERT'S DAIRY SUPPLEMENT prevents the development of horn flies, face flies, house flies and stable flies in the manure of treated cattle but it is not effective against existing adult flies. When starting a feeding program during the fly season it may be necessary to use other control measures to reduce the population of existing adult flies.

In some cases supplemental fly control measures may be needed in and around dry lots, calf pens and barns to control adult house flies and stable flies which can breed not only in cattle manure but in other decaying vegetable matter or silage on the premises.

In order to achieve optimum fly control GILBERT'S DAIRY SUPPLEMENT should be used in conjunction with other good sanitation and management practices.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water or food by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Dispose of in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place.
