DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

WHERE TO APPLY

Natural and Manmade contained ponds, lakes & fountains, including ornamental, recreational, fish rearing & fish farming ponds with little or no outflow.

Do Not apply directly to streams, other natural bodies of water or any body of water not under total control of the user.

Do not apply to water that will be used for human consumption.

HOW TO APPLY

Pour from the container near shoreline into water. It will mix throughout. For an early control, pour onto the ice in a meter diameter circle. It will melt a hole & disperse underneath.

WHEN TO APPLY

For best results, apply before growing season starts, or when growth is on the bottom. Less effective when growth is near surface (2 ft.) in that case, physical removal or chemical killing of growth already above surface may be done before AQUASHADE is applied.

When using an aquatic herbicide, follow all label restrictions, precautions and directions for use.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Do not apply to water for SWIMMING PURPOSES when the product is used.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Shoreline non-target plants (cattails, water lilies) may suffer contact burn if material is accidentally poured on them.
Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

RECOMMENDED DOSAGE RATES

Apply one gallon (1ppm) per acre of water with 4 foot average depth (one half deepest point).

1ppm When submerged weeds and algae are growing at depths greater than two feet, such as: leafy pondweed, Chara, Slender naiad, Filamentous green and blue green algae, Spirogyra-Water milfoil (Treat early).

2ppm to PREVENT future production of HYDRILLA.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and place in trash collection. Store above 32° to prevent freezing.
