PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. (Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling). Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory depression and convulsion may be needed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply in marine and/or estuarine oil fields. Do not discharge treated effluent into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with a NPDES permit. For guidance contact your Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

For use in industrial processes only. Not for domestic use. See Technical Bulletin for recommended use concentrations.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate tha cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed o in a landfill approved for pesticides, or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

- ☐ METAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling reconditioning, or disposal in an approved landfill or bury in a safe place. Containers over 30 gallons should be resealed before offering for reconditioning.
- □ PLASTIC: Containers under 30 gallons must not be reused bushould be triple rinsed and disposed of in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers or buried in a safe place. Containers over 30 gallons are to be resealed and offered for reconditioning or triple rinsed (or equivalent) and offered for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in an approved landfill or buried in a safe place.
