GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically processed should be disposed of in a landfill
approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Do not contaminate water, food or feed
by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Container Disposal: a) Containers of 30 gallons or more - recast container and offer for reconditioning, or:
b) All containers - triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning or disposal
in approved landfill, or bury in a safe place.
