#### DANGER

### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Corrosive, may cause severe skin irritation or chemical burns to broken skin. Causes eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shelld and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash hands after handling. Vacate poorly ventilated areas as soon as possible. Do not return until odors have dissipated.

Directions Por Swimming Pool Chlorination Form new pool or for spring start up, superchlorinate with one (1) pint (46 fls., ozs.) of Pool Guard sodium hypochlorite solution for each 2500 ক্সীটাঁর of water, অভান্যবিত্তage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE A) Adjust pool WMer on to 7.6 7.2 range and maintain,

B) Add manually or by a feeder device, Pool Guard sodium chlorite solution at a rate to maintain an available chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. One half pint (8 flu. ozs.) of Pool Guard sodkum hypochlorite solution for each 6000 gallons of water will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight, Frequency of additions to maintain 0.6 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine will depend on remper ature and number of swimmers. Use test kit to make certain the pH and Chlorine residual are in the proper range.

NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage, as necessary, to obtain the required level of available chtorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a coot, dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discard by placing in trash collection or burying in an approved land fill. Product or rinsate that cannot be used, should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning or equipment:
