1. For swimming pools, use 1/2 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water. Add to the pool water and allow to circulate for 24 hours before swimming. For hot tubs, use 1/4 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water. Add to the hot tub water and allow to circulate for 24 hours before use.

DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTION OF POTABLE WATER FOR HOME WELL WATER SYSTEMS

1. For home well water systems, use 1/2 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water. Add to the water and allow to circulate for 24 hours before use.

DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING FOOD PROCESSING OR DAIRY EQUIPMENT

1. For sanitizing food processing or dairy equipment, use 1/2 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water. Add to the water and allow to circulate for 24 hours before use.

NOTE:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store in areas with high humidity or near water. Do not store in areas with high temperatures. Do not store in areas with high concentrations of acids, alkalis, amines, alcohols, aldehydes, amines, ammonia, acids, detergents, organic acids, organic bases, organic peroxides, organic solvents.
