DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Protect SP 20 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Protect SP 20. For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial fluid ounces of Protect SP 20 per 1,000 gallons of water. To remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a pool add initially 20 to 36.5 fluid ounces of Protect SP 20 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Protect SP 20 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 4 to 6 fluid ounces of Protect SP 20 per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 2 fluid ounces of Protect SP 20 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Protect SP 20 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. Protect SP 20 is compatible with all other pool chemicals used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains and should be used at an alkaline pH. Protect SP 20 can be used on decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals and chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Protect SP 20 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and disposed of with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in plastic and dispose of with clear water.
