3. Revise the precautionary statements to read:

Disinfecting instructions: Hold dispenser 6 to 8 inches from surface to be treated, spray pre-cleaned surface thoroughly wetting area and allow to remain on surface for at least 10 minutes at room temperature (69°F). Follow by wiping surface dry using a clean cloth or paper towel.
