ALMONDS: Brown Rot, Scab — Use 6 pounds per 100 gallons of water in pre-bloom, bloom and post-bloom periods. Apply when disease threatens during rain periods and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals.

APPLES AND PEARS: For Scab or Powdery Mildew control, use as a spray in Pre-blossom, Calyx and Early cover sprays. Use 6 to 8 pounds of EAGLE WETTABLE SULPHUR or 4 to 6 pounds of EAGLE WETTABLE SULPHUR plus 2 to 3 pounds Polysulphide Compound or 2 gallons of Liquid Lime Sulphur Solution per 100 gallons of dilute spray. Sulphur may injure certain varieties of APPLES. Check specific varietal tolerance to sulphur prior to using. Pears only: Do not apply after fruit begins to turn down. Fall Clean-up Spray: Bilster Mites, European Red Mites and Twospotted Spider Mites - Use 6 pounds of EAGLE WETTABLE SULPHUR plus 6 pounds of Polysuiphide Compound or 5 gallons of Liquid Lime Sulphur Solution to each 100 gailons of dilute spray.

BLACKBERRIES, BOYSENBERRIES, GOOSE-BERRIES, LOGANBERRIES, RASPBERRIES, STRAWBERRIES: Powdery Mildew - Use 2 pounds per 100 gallons of water. Apply when disease first appears and repeat as necessary.

CHERRIES: Brown Rot, Leaf Spot, Powdery Mildew, Rust, Scab and Stem Blight — Use 5 to 10 pounds per 100 gallons of water. (By ground apply a minimum of 200 gallons of water per acre.) Apply in the pre-bloom, bloom and post-bloom periods. Apply when disease threatens during rain periods and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals. CITRUS: Citrus Flat Mite, Yuma Spider Mite, Sixspotted Mite and Citrus Rust Mite - Use 5 to 12 pounds per 100 gallons of water (75 to 125 pounds per acre). Apply when mites appear and repeat as necessary.

GRAPES: Powdery Mildew — Use 2 to 5 pounds per 100 gallons of dilute spray. Use as a spray beginning when shoots are 6 to 8 Inches long and repeat at 7 to 10 day Intervals. Ground application preferred. Concord and other Labrusa type grapes may be injured by sulphur.

PEACHES AND NECTARINES: Brown Rot, Leaf Spot, Powdery Mildew, Rust, Scan and Shot Hole - Use 5 to 10 pounds per 100 gallons of water. (By ground apply a minimum of 200 gallons of water per acre.) Apply in the pre-bloom, bloom

and post-bloom periods. Apply when disease threatens during rain periods and repeat at 7 to 10 day Intervals.

PLUMS AND PRUNES: Brown Rot, Leaf Spot, Powdery Mildew, Rust, Scab and Shot Hole --Use 5 to 10 pounds per 100 gallons of water. (By ground apply a minimum of 200 gallons of water per acre.) Apply In the pre-bloom, bloom and post-bloom periods. Apply when disease threatens during rain periods and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals.

TOMATOES: Tomato Russet Mita — Use 12 to 25 pounds per acre. Apply with ground equipment at the rate of 60 to 250 gallons of water per acre. Use only application equipment which has paddle type agitation. Continuous and complete agitation is necessary. Apply when disease first threathens and repeat as necessary.
