 - b. Add an aspiration hazard statement to the Statement of Practical Treatment for oral exposure.
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray sleeping pets, around baseboards, window and wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be placed in quarters after spraying of pet area.

OUTDOOR USE: Ants, clover mites, crickets, fleas, millipede and brown dog ticks. Test areas thoroughly including outside of screens, doors, window frames, patios or other places where insects may enter. Repeat as needed. Do not spray vegetation.
