Spray behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, in and around waste containers. Repeat as required. Do not spray foodstuffs or house plants.

For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until spray is completely dry.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be places in animal quarters after spraying of pet area. Do not spray animals with this product.

OUTDOOR USES: For the control of ants, clover mites, crickets, earwigs, fleas, millipedes and brown dog ticks. Spray infested areas thoroughly, including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios and other places where insects may enter. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation
