For hard-to-kill perennials as Johnsongrass, bracken fern, horseweed, bluegrass, purple top, and goldenrod, 1 gallon of DEAD VEG and apply at the spray mixture per

#### STORAGE

Do not contaminate storage or disposal. STORAGE: Keep container not in use. If container has leaked, contain material with sand and place in closed, labeled disposal.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse container, then offer for recycling and dispose of in accordance with procedures approved by local authorities.
