

recirculating cooling tower systems and industrial microbiological slime. Prior to the use of CWT-D, industrial and/or commercial recirculating cooling towers should be cleaned to remove algal growth, microbiological slimes, and other deposits. Initial slug addition of 12.0 to 17.9 fl. oz. of CWT-D per 1000 gal. of water to provide 100 to 150 ppm CWT-D, based on total weight of water until control is evident. Make subsequent slug additions of CWT-D per 1000 gal. of water every 2 to 3 days. Slug addition depends upon the relative amount of microbiological problem. Slug additions should be made until control is evident.

which maintain effective mist-eliminating components. Cleaned to remove bacterial slime and other deposits. 35.9 fl. oz. of CWT-D is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved. 21.0 to 35.9 fl. oz. of CWT-D per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 1 to 5 days. Slug addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff. Slug additions may be made to the sump or the recirculating system.
