DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

"AQUACIDE" is used to clean air-washing systems and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial air-washing systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slime, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 37 fluid ounces of "AQUACIDE" of water to provide a concentration of 37 "AQUACIDE" in the system, is recommended. Repeat initial slug additions of 1.0 AQUACIDE per 1000 80 parts per million of "AQUACIDE" employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions should be made in the sur-
"AQUACIDE" is used in air-washing systems that maintain effective moisture. To its use, systems should be cleaned to remove deposits. An initial slug dose of 14.8 "AQUACIDE" per 1000 gallons of water should be employed. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved. Initial dosages of 10.1 to 24.7 fluid ounces of "AQUACIDE" per 1000 gallons of water should be employed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in the collection trays of the airwash system.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
STORAGE: Do not stack more than four drums high. Leaking drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a sanitary landfill, by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities.
