GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Chem-Tech 12N is used as a defoliant and desiccant for field crops. It must be applied to remove weeds and other undesirable vegetation and deposits. An initial application rate of 100 pounds per acre is recommended per 1000 gallons of water. A second application may be made if necessary.

Subsequent applications of 100 pounds per acre may be made every 1000 gallons of water as required. The frequency of application depends upon the severity of the infestation and the condition of the crop. A minimum of 1000 gallons of water should be used.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITED do not store near food or feed or disposal. Do not dump in surface water.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL Pesticides may be disposed of by physical chemically reprocessed, incinerated, or buried in a permitted landfill.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL Containers may be disposed of by physical chemically reprocessed, incinerated, or buried in a permitted landfill.

REUSED containers should be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected before being reused for pest control purposes.

30-gallon capacity drums may be disposed of by physical chemically reprocessed, incinerated, or buried in a permitted landfill.

UNAPPROVED CONTAINERS may be disposed of by physical chemically reprocessed, incinerated, or buried in a permitted landfill.

GENERAL Obstruction of drainage, infiltration, or runoff is prohibited.
