The proposed amendment to the registration for the product cited above under The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide And Rodenticide Act, as amended revising the label in response to the DEET RED, PR Notices 2001-1, 2001-6, 97-6, 97-5, 97-4 and 83-3 is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1) Change the Precautionary Statements to read:

"May cause eye injury.Harmful if swallowed Do not get in eyes. Avoid contact with lips and mouth.Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.".

- 2) Add the following to the First Aid section:
  - If you suspect a reaction to this product:
  - \* Discontinue use;
  - \* Take off contaminated clothing;
  - \* Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes;
  - \* Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

3) Add the following statements to the First Aid section:

"For additional information in case of emergency call toll free( insert telephone number)."

"Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment.".

4) Change the Ingredient Statement to read:

Note: Your suppliers are no longer claiming that their products are 100% active. Therefore you must adjust the amount of the supplier's product that you use. This will differ depending on which supplier you use.

A revised Confidential Statement Of Formula(CSF) must be submitted.

5) Add the following Note To Physician: "Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."

This product is not being re-registered at this time. Product specific efficacy data will be required. Once the efficacy guidelines are in place, you will be notified of the efficacy requirements.

Also, to meet the requirement of the DEET RED, the product, must be packaged in containers utilizing a concave trigger to help aim the product or other comparable mechanism that will ensure that the product will not be inadvertently sprayed in the eyes.

A stamped copy of the amended label submitted on August 18, 2003 is enclosed for your records. Submit two copies of the final label before the product is released for shipment under this revised label.


