For a new pool or for spring start-up, superchlorinate with one (1) pint (16 flu. ozs.) of Boca Pool-Trol Sanitizer sodium hypochlorite solution for each 25GO gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine

#### FOR POOL MAINTENANCE:

A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.6 7.2 range and maintain.

B) Add manually or by a feeder device, Boos Pool-Trot Sanitizer redium hypochlorite solution at a rate to maintain an available chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. One half pint (8 flu, ezs.) of Boca Pool-Trol Sanitizer medium hypochlorite solution for each 6000 gallons of water will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight.
