DANTOGARD™ preserves and aids in the control of the growth of bacteria and fungi in liquid detergents, soft soaps, room deodorizers, and water-based paints for industrial and household use.

DANTOGARD™ preservative should be added at the rate of 3.4 lbs. to 13.8 pounds per 1000 lbs. or 3400 to 13,800 ppm, based upon the total weight of the formulation to be protected.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

Pesticide or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

Triple rinse the container or equivalent method before sending to drum conditioner, or destroy by perforation or crushing and burying in a safe place. Consult Federal, State or local authorities for approved alternative procedures.
