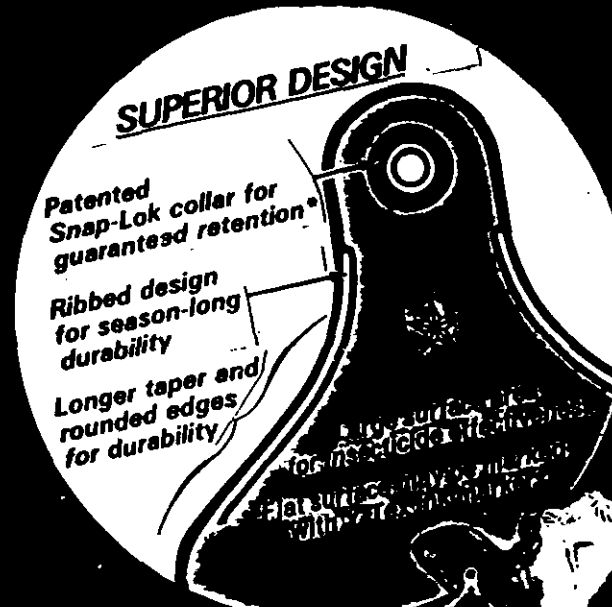

To remain effective up to 5 months. For season-long control of Gulf Coast ticks and face flies, attach two ear tags per animal (one in each ear). Apply when flies first appear in spring. Replace as necessary. Apply with the Y-TEX two-piece tagging system.



For use on dairy (lactating and non-lactating) and beef cattle and calves to control susceptible horn flies, face flies, Gulf Coast ticks, spnose ear ticks and as an aid to control lice, stable flies and houseflies.
