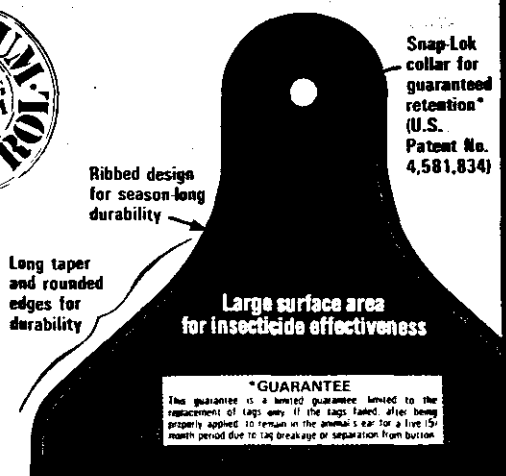

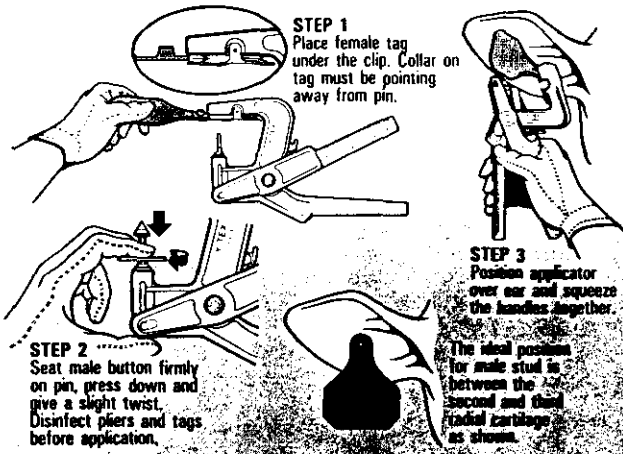

Apply as shown with the Y-TEX two-piece tagging system.
