Your submission dated February 6, 2006

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable and a stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Please make the following revisions when preparing the actual finished labeling:

- 1. In the Hazards to Humans, after "Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing." add "Avoid breathing vapors.".
- 2. In the NOTE under the heading Directions for Use, regarding "...chemical-resistant gloves made of rubber or any waterproof material (selection category A)", the Agency agrees that this could be stated as "...chemical-resistant gloves made of rubber or any waterproof material (thickness equal to or greater than 14 mils)". In case end-users contact your marketing staff regarding specific glove material selection, the Agency recommends that you provide that staff with the chart downloaded from the EPA's web site located at www.epa.gov/oppfead1/safety/workers/equip.htm and tell them that the appropriate category for this product is selection category A.

This letter does <u>not</u> constitute reregistration of the subject product. Such a determination will await completion of the Agency's cumulative risk assessment for the group of organophosphate pesticides.

Please submit 4 copies of the finished label prior to release for shipment under the amended labeling.

Apply 2 tags per animal (1 in each ear) for optimum control of horn flies, lice, Gulf Coast ticks and spinose ear ticks for up to 5 months. Two tags per animal also provides substantial reductions of face flies and aids in control of stable flies and house flies. Apply when pests appear.

Winter Season: Apply 1 new tag per animal in late fall to early winter to control biting and sucking lice. Kills biting lice and most sucking lice within 2 weeks. Protects from lice reinfestation for 2-3 months.

Apply new tags in spring for fly and tick control. Replace as necessary. Apply as shown with the Y-TEX 2-piece tagging system. All animals in the herd should be tagged. Calves less than 3 months of age should not be tagged or ear damage may result. To minimize development of insecticide resistance, remove used tags at end of fly and lice seasons and




