# Dear Mr. Kellerby:

The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

1) Due to spray drift concerns, you must change your application instructions for small hive beetle to read the following:

"When hives are present, applications may only be made with a sprinkler can. Hand pump sprayers may only be used when hives are <u>not</u> present and only for pre-placement cleanup of apiary."

On the front panel, change the statement "Now approved for aid in control of the small hive beetle, *Aethina tumida*, in honey bee colonies" to read "Now approved for aid in control of the small hive beetle, *Aethina tumida*,

Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. This product contains a petroleum distillate and may pose an aspiration hazard.

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

"Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."


Additionally, it should also contain 1) technical information on symptomatology; 2) use of supportive treatments to maintain life functions; 3) medicine that will counteract the specific physiological effects of the pesticide and 4) a company telephone number to specific medical personnel who can provide specialized medical advice.

The "Note to Physician" should be located in close proximity to the "Statements of Practical Treatment" but should be clearly distinguished from it. In other words, it should not be mixed in with the "Statement of Practical Treatment" but should appear below the last statement of practical treatment.

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- When treating rooms/animal quarters, please use the following statement to specify how long a ventilation period is required:
  - "Upon reentry, open windows and ventilate for at least XXX minutes (Please specify a time. If no ventilation period can readily be proposed, a minimum of 2 hours is suggested).
- 7) Please specify how often your product should be reapplied. Please note that it is no longer permissible to state "Repeat as necessary" or "Repeat treatment as necessary". The duration between treatments should be based on your efficacy data.
- 8) Under horses and dogs use directions, limit low pressure spray use to horses only.
