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- d. Based on a Toxicity IV classification for eye exposure an "IF IN EYES" statement is not required. However if you prefer to retain this statement change to "Hold eyes open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eyes. Call a Poison Control Center for treatment advice.".
- e. The label must list a restriction against simultaneous use of ear tag and dust formulations.
- f. The label must restrict against the "free- choice" uses for dust bags (i.e., this registration is for the "forced daily" types of uses). This may require deletion of the use by dust bag. There is not enough control over delivery rate with the free-choice scenarios to ensure residue levels at or below established tolerances.
- 3. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Beef and Dairy Cattle, Sheep, Goats and Horses: Can be applied by dust bag, shaker can, dusting glove and mechanical dust applicator.

Horn flies, lice and face flies (by dust bag): Place contents of package in any commercially available dust bag; suspend bag in areas frequented by cattle or in gateways or lanes through which the animals must pass daily for water, feed, or minerals. Bags may also be placed in loafing sheds or in front of mineral feeders. For dairy cows, bags may be suspended in the exit through which the cows leave the milking barn. The bags should hang four (4) to six (6) inches below the backline of the cattle. For reduction of face flies, bags must be be a height so that the face is dusted.

Hom flies, lice, face flies, stable flies, ticks and keds (direct application): Apply up to 2 oz. (6 tablespoons) of dust per animal evenly into the hair over the head, ears, neck, shoulders, back, and tailhead. For spinoss ear ticks, apply approximately 1/3 ounce (1 tablespoon) inside each ear. For stable flies, apply also to legs. Repeat as necessary but not more often than once in 3 days.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage

Store in cool, dry place. Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Disposal

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal

Completely empty container into application equipment. Then dispose of empty container in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
