NOTE: This product is **not** being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.


In addition, please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statement of Formulation (CSF) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.  
**READ THE ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE.**  
**PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS**  
• Do not apply this product in a way that will contact children, either directly or through drift. Do not allow people or pets to enter treatment areas until dusts have settled.  
• Do not apply this product in a way that will contact children, either directly or through drift. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults or pets either directly or through drift.  
• Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.  
• Do not water to the point of run-off.  
• Do not make applications during rain.

**Home Vegetable Gardens/Outdoor Ornamental Plants:** Use a dust applicator such as a shaker can, dust gun, puffer or other tubular rotary dustier or other appropriate duster available. Dust lightly to cover both upper and lower leaf surfaces with a thin even film of dust. Apply when air is calm to avoid drift and contact with eyes and skin. Start applying at the farthest corner of the treatment area and work backward to avoid contact with treated surfaces. Allow dust to settle in treated areas before reentering.

**Outdoor Ornamental Plants:**  
Contact insects directly whenever possible. Controls aphids, cicadas, corn earworms, fall cankerworms, inchworms, leafminers, leafrollers, mealybugs, bagworms, and exposed thrips on the following plants:  
Agave, Arizona Cypress, Aster, Azalea, Begonia, Coleus, Common Ninkabark, Common Snowflake, Eucalyptus, Eustoma, English Ivy, Gladiolus, Gold Bell, Hypoxis, Ivy, Lilac, Marigold, Mark Orange, Nannyberry, Palm, Parsley, Pea Shrub, Petunia, Philodendron, Poinsettia, Rhododendron, Rose, Snapdragon, Texas Wax Plant, Weeping Fig and Zinnia.  
May also be used on such plants as carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwood, luscina, geraniums, crassula, grapevines (ornamental), laurels, aloes and wandering Jews.

**Home Vegetable Gardens:**  
Asparagus (post-harvest) - To control cutworms and asparagus beetle, apply to plants as needed to ensure uniform coverage. Do not make more than 4 applications per season. Can be applied up to 3 days prior to harvest.  
Asparagus (post-harvest) - To control larval stages of asparagus beetle, tarnished plant bug, lygus bugs and adult Japanese beetles, treat fern or bush growth after spear harvest when insects are present.  
Cauliflower - To control leaf miner, cabbage looper, cabbage aphid, cabbage looper, apply every 5 to 10 days as needed. Do not make more than 10 applications on cabbage and 6 applications on the other cole crops per season.  
Corn (Sweet) - To control corn earworms, European corn borers, fall armyworms, southern armyworms, apply to plants every 5 days as needed. Do not make more than 6 applications per season. Can be applied up to 1 day prior to harvest.  
Cucurbits: Batsan pear (bitter melon), Chinese waxgourd (Chinese preserving melon), citrus melon, cucumber, gherkin, edging melon, melons including hybrids such as cantaloupe, casaba, crenshaw, honeydew, honeyball, muskmelon, and Persian melon, pumpkin, summer & winter squash and watermelon - To control aphids, cabbage looper, cucumber beetle (adults), cutworms, leafhoppers, leafminers, mealyworm, pickleworm, plant bugs, squash bugs, ensure uniform coverage of plants. Do not make more than 8 applications per crop per season. Can be applied up to the day of harvest.  
Eggplant - To control Colorado potato beetle, vegetable leaf miner, ensure uniform coverage of plants. Do not make more than 16 applications per season. Can be applied up to 3 days prior to harvest.  
Leafy Vegetables: amaranth, arugula, celery, celtuce, chervil, corn salad, chrysanthemum (edible-leaved and gariand), cress (garden and upland), dandelion, dock, endive, fennel, lettuce (head and leaf), orch, parsley, purslane, (garden and winter), rhubarb, spinach and Swiss chard - To control alfalfa looper, aphids, beet armyworm, cabbage looper, corn earworm, cutworms, European corn borer, fall armyworm, green cloverworm, southern armyworm, tobacco budworm, vegetable leaf miner, apply every 5 to 10 days as needed. Do not make more than 7 applications per crop per season. Can be applied up to 1 day prior to harvest.  
Potatoes - To control beet armyworm, Colorado potato beetle, potato leafhopper, potato aphid, potato tuberworm, cabbage looper, cutworms, European corn borer, potato psyllid, tarnished plant bug, apply to plants as needed. Do not make more than 12 applications per season. Can be applied up to 7 days prior to harvest.  
Peppers - To control vegetable leaf miner, cabbage looper, flea beetle, corn earworm, pepper weevil, European corn borer, apply to plants as needed. Do not make more than 8 applications per season. Can be applied up to 3 days prior to harvest.  
Tomatoes - Do not apply on cherry tomatoes and varieties yielding tomatoes less than one inch in diameter. Do control black and blueberry armyworms, tomato pinworms, tomato budworms, hornworms, granulate cutworms, Colorado potato beetle, cabbage looper, apply to plants to ensure uniform coverage. Do not make more than 6 applications per season. Can be applied up to day of harvest.

**Animals:**  
Poultry: To control Northern Fowl Mites and Lice, apply directly to birds at a rate of 1 lb. per 100 birds. Ensure thorough treatment of vent area. To control Northern Fowl Mite, Poultry Mite and Lice in poultry houses, apply to floors, roosts and interior surfaces at a rate of 1 lb. per 40 sq. ft. Do not apply directly to eggs or nest filler. Do not contaminate feed or drinking water.  
Swine: Lice on Swine Direct Application: Apply only 1 ounce per head as a uniform coat to the head, shoulder and back by use of a shaker can or suitable mechanical dust applicator. Do not apply more often than once every 10 days. In severe infestation, both animals and the bedding may be treated. Do not ship animals for slaughter within 5 days of treatment.

**Ants:**  
Ants: Carpenter Ants: Treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and hills, cracks and crevices and other areas of entry.
