
ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to birds, fish and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by disposal of used tags.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Reformulation or repackaging of this product is prohibited.

For adequate control of horn flies, attach one tag per animal. For optimum control of horn flies, control of ear ticks, and as an aid in the control of face flies, lice, stable flies and house flies, attach one tag to each ear (two per animal). Replace as necessary. YT-600 tags have been proven to be effective against pyrethroid resistant horn flies for up to five months. Apply as shown with a Y-TEX 2-piece tag applicator (i.e. UltraTagger *plus*). Disinfect tag applicator before use. To minimize development of insecticide resistance in horn flies, remove used tags at the end of the season and follow the recommended tag rotation program. Calves less than 3 months of age should not be tagged as ear damage may result. **Remove tags before slaughter**.



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

<u>Pesticide Storage</u>: Store in a cool place in original container. Opened pouches containing ear tags should be resealed for storage.

<u>Pesticide Disposal:</u> Waste (spent tags) resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

<u>Container Disposal:</u> Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Dispose of empty pouch in a landfill or by incineration or by other procedures allowed by state and local authorities.
