IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

Use as a disinfectant in accordance with the label directions. Do not use in a manner inconsistent with the label.

ONLY FOR SALE TO, USE, AND STORAGE BY SERVICEPERSONS

FOR CLEANING: Lightly soiled areas— surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1 ounce of SURE-CIDE per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned surface with fresh water.

Heavily soiled areas— mop or brush soiled surface with a solution containing 2-3 ounces of SURE-CIDE per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned surface with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION: To disinfect walls, floors and other hard non-porous surfaces in schools, restaurants, restrooms and other public areas, mop or brush with a fresh solution containing 1 ounce of SURE-CIDE per gallon of water so as to maintain a thoroughly wetted surface for ten minutes. All soiled surfaces must be pre-cleaned prior to disinfection. Follow directions for cleaning. Those surfaces which may later come in contact with food must be rinsed with clear water of drinking quality. Do not reuse used solution.

To disinfect hard non-porous surfaces in locker rooms, shower stalls, walkways around pools and other areas against pathogenic fungi, mop or brush with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces of SURE-CIDE per 3 gallons of water so as to maintain a thoroughly wetted surface for ten minutes. This solution will destroy *Trichophyton interdigitale*, a causative agent of athlete's foot. All soiled surfaces must be pre-cleaned prior to disinfection. Follow directions for cleaning. Do not reuse used solution.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION: To disinfect walls, floors, furniture and other hard non-porous surfaces in hospitals and nursing homes, mop or brush with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces of SURE-CIDE per gallon of water so as to maintain a thoroughly wetted surface for ten minutes. All soiled surfaces must be pre-cleaned prior to disinfection. Follow directions for cleaning. Those surfaces that are heavily soiled with blood, fecal material or exudates should be thoroughly scrubbed with a solution containing 2 ounces of SURE-CIDE per gallon of water before disinfection. Do not reuse used solution. This product has not been tested for effectiveness against *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* and must not be relied upon when tuberculocidal activity is intended by the user.

DEODORIZATION: Prior to deodorization of bathroom areas, garbage pits, diaper pits, and storage areas, kennel areas and other areas where noxious odors may develop, remove all garbage, refuse, food and/or animals. Pre-clean surfaces using pressurized water where possible before deodorization. To deodorize, mop or brush surfaces thoroughly with a solution containing 2 ounces of SURE-CIDE per gallon of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. If plastic, do not reuse empty container.

DISPOSAL: Pesticide or insecticide that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Triple rinse empty plastic containers and for metal containers offer for recycling or reconditioning. For plastic containers, dispose in an incinerator or dispose in landfill approved for pesticide containers or bury in a safe place. Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.

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Directions for Use
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply ~~ALVA-QUAT~~ with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device. When applied with a mechanical spray device, surface must be sprayed until thoroughly wetted. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when the use of solution becomes visibly dirty.

Disinfection in Hospitals, Nursing Homes and Other Health Care Institutions: For disinfecting floors, walls, countertops, bathing areas, lavatories, bedframes, tables, chairs, garbage pails and other hard, non-porous surfaces.

Add 7.0 oz. ~~ALVA-QUAT~~ to 4.5 gallons water. Apply to previously cleaned hard surfaces. At this use level, A-SeptiQuat is effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Salmonella choleraesuis* in the presence of 5% blood serum when evaluated by the AOAC Use-Dilution test.

Disinfection in Institutions, Industry and Schools: Add 4.0 oz. of ~~ALVA-QUAT~~ to 4.5 gallons of water. At 1.0 oz. to 2.25 gallons of water use level, the fungicidal effectiveness of ~~ALVA-QUAT~~ in the presence of 5% blood serum against *Trichophyton Mentagrophytes* has been shown utilizing the AOAC Fungicidal Test.

Disinfection of Barber Tools: Pre-cleaned barber tools (such as combs, brushes, razors, and scissors) can be disinfected by immersing in a 1.0 oz. per gallon solution of ~~ALVA-QUAT~~.

Disinfection of Poultry Equipment, Animal Quarters and Kennels: Poultry brooders, watering founts, feeding equipment and other animal quarters (such as stalls and kennel areas) can be disinfected after thorough cleaning by applying a solution of 4.0 oz. ~~ALVA-QUAT~~ to 4.5 gallons of water. Small utensils should be immersed in this solution.

Prior to disinfection, all poultry, other animals and their feeds must be removed from the premises. This includes emptying all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Remove all litter and droppings from floors, walls and other surfaces occupied or traversed by poultry or other animals.

After disinfection, ventilate buildings, coops and other closed spaces. Do not house poultry, other animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried.

All treated equipment that will contact feed or drinking water must be rinsed with potable water before reuse.
