DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Feed JOHNSON'S HI-VIM R.O.L. CATTLE BALANCER at the rate of 1/2 lb. (8 ounces) per head per day by mixing it into the ground grain or complete daily ration.
Start feeding early in the spring before flies begin to appear and continue feeding throughout the summer into the fall until cold weather restricts fly activity.
JOHNSON'S HI-VIM R.O.L. CATTLE BALANCER may be fed up to slaughter and to lactating dairy cows.
JOHNSON'S HI-VIM R.O.L. CATTLE BALANCER prevents the development of horn flies, face flies, house flies, and stable flies in the manure of treated cattle, but is not effective against existing adult flies. When starting a feeding program during the fly season, it is desirable to use other control measures to reduce the population of existing adult flies. In some cases, supplemental fly control measures may be needed in and around cattle lots and buildings to control adult house flies and stable flies which can breed not only in cattle manure but in other decaying vegetable matter or silage on the premises.
In order to achieve optimum fly control, JOHNSON'S HI-VIM CATTLE BALANCER should be used in conjunction with other good management and sanitation practices.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water or food by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable federal, state, or local procedures.
