Mix 10 lbs. R.O.L. Swine Premix per
ton of meal type feed and offer free
choice. This is equivalent to
22.7 mg. of Rabon per lb. of feed.

SOWS, BOARS AND BREEDING GILTS:
Mix 20 lbs. R.O.L. Swine Premix per
ton of meal type feed and offer free
choice. This is equivalent to
45.4 mg. of Rabon per lb. of feed.

Start feeding early in the spring
before flies begin to appear and
continue feeding throughout the
summer into the fall until cold
weather restricts fly activity.

In order to achieve optimum fly
control, R.O.L. Swine Premix
should be used in conjunction with
other good management and sanitation
practices.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by
storage or disposal. Storage: Store in a dry
