The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the revised labeling:
 - a. The **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals** section must be changed to read:

"May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Harmful if inhaled. Causes eye irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Avoid breathing vapor. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse."
 - b. The statement "Refer to attached Technical Bulletin for formulating and other information" must appear on the label under the **DIRECTIONS FOR USE** section.
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for ~~shipment~~ ~~of the product constitutes~~ acceptance of these conditions.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FOR PESTICIDE EMERGENCY

IF SWALLOWED Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
