PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Harmful if inhaled. Causes eye irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Avoid breathing vapor. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic invertebrates. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

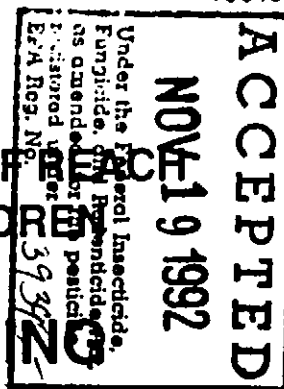
1. **STORAGE:** Containers should be stored in a cool, dry well ventilated area. Do not expose to prolonged heat. Contact with flame or high temperatures will cause an explosion. This product will support combustion. Keep container closed when not in use.
2. **PROHIBITIONS:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.
3. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
4. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling, reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved State and local procedures.
5. Consult Federal, State or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FOR PESTICIDE EMERGENCY

CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY: If a known exposure occurs or is suspected, immediately initiate the recommended procedures below. Simultaneously contact a Poison Control Center, a physician or the nearest hospital. Describe the situation and follow advice given. Note: Be sure to advise the physician that the compound is a cholinesterase inhibitor, and follow the physician's advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

FOR EYE CONTACT: Hold eyelids apart and flush with large amounts of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

FOR SKIN CONTACT: Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes. Get medical attention if irritation occurs. Wash clothing before re-use.

IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air. Seek medical attention if respiratory irritation occurs.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Exposure may cause cholinesterase inhibition. Atropine by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal when administered early and in conjunction with atropine.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
