Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."
- e. Insert "Caution" before Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

MUNICIPAL SANITARY SEWERS: During periods of low flow use one gallon each 6 to 12 month period at each junction or terminal ahead of where there may be an organic problem. To be effective the sewer must be opened sufficiently to permit some water flow. This can be done by mechanical or chemical means.

STORM SEWERS: Use one gallon each 300 to 400 feet per year. Make application during periods of light flow. In dry weather introduce a flow with a hose. If storm drains become almost plugged, repeat treatment 3 or 4 times at two-week intervals.

COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL SEWERS: During periods of low flow use one gallon each 6 to 12 month period at each junction or terminal ahead of where there may be an organic problem. To be effective the sewer must be opened sufficiently to permit some water flow. This can be done by mechanical or chemical means.

HOUSEHOLD SEWERS: Use one gallon twice yearly - Spring and early Fall. Apply in toilet nearest sewer line at night or during periods of reduced flow using one quart at a time flushing each quart separately. If sewer is completely blocked, use mechanical or chemical methods to obtain some flow. Follow with repeat monthly treatments until free flow is restored, then resume on semi-annual preventative treatment.

NOTE; Do not apply in sink or tub drains.
