

Poly[oxyethylene(dimethyliminio)ethylene-(dimethyliminio)ethylene dichloride] 10.0 %

INERT INGREDIENT 90.0 %

This product contains 0.85 lb. of active ingredient per gallon and weighs 8.49 lb. per gallon.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

DIRECTIONS FOR

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner not specified on the label.

For swimming pools, hot tubs, whirlpools, decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae, use ALGAECIDE in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness use ALGAECIDE decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae. For the procedure for use, see label under EPA Reg. No. ALGAECIDE.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of ALGAECIDE fluid ounces of ALGAECIDE remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of pools having just visible algae growth add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces of ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 7 to 10 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae require an initial dose of 8 fluid ounces of ALGAECIDE per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 fluid ounce of ALGAECIDE should be made every 7 to 10 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

ALGAECIDE will kill algae in swimming pools during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. Pools that are not regularly treated during the swimming season and are treated with ALGAECIDE 65 fluid ounces of algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. Season pools have some visible algae growth, add ALGAECIDE 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. It may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times.

ALGAECIDE is compatible with chlorine products and is effective against algae. ALGAECIDE can be used in conjunction with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix ALGAECIDE with chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Labeling should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wipe out container with water.
