DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION

1. Determine the volume of water in the pool. Measure the length and width of the pool in feet. Multiply length by width by 5.9 to determine the volume of water in the pool in gallons.

DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTION OF POTABLE WATER FOR HOME WELL WATER SYSTEMS

1. Determine the volume of water in the well. Measure the diameter of the well in inches. Multiply the diameter by the diameter by 0.785 to determine the area of the well in square inches. Multiply the area by the depth of the well in feet by 7.48 to determine the volume of water in the well in gallons.

DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING FOOD PROCESSING OR DAIRY EQUIPMENT

1. Determine the volume of water in the equipment. Measure the length, width and height of the equipment in feet. Multiply length by width by height by 7.48 to determine the volume of water in the equipment in gallons.
