The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling submit an amended Confidential Statement of Formula for your product which demonstrates that your product is within certified limits for TBT release rate which places it within the release rate limit imposed by the Organotin Antifouling Paint Control Act (OAPCA) of 1988. Your product was certified as being within OAPCA limit by the Agency in its letter dated 4/25/89.
3. Submit acceptable prototype specifications and materials for a certification and training program for the use/disposal and removal of TBT antifouling paints and paint wastes within 180 days from the date of your application to amend this registration. Your application was dated October 26, 1988. The prototype specifications and materials must be submitted by May 26, 1989. The minimum elements to be addressed in the certification and training program are identified in the Agency's Notice at 53 FR 39038.

4. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Delete the statement "District of Columbia, March 1, 1982" from the second paragraph, right-hand to the top center of the front panel. See item (9a) of "The Label" enclosure.
 - b. The statement "Do not use in areas where it would soon be moved or where it might be difficult to contain" is to be deleted from paragraph 2.
 - c. The sentence "Do not use in areas where it would soon be moved, and use in the manner" through "Anticipated Events." is to be deleted from paragraph 3.
 - d. Replace the "Pesticide Disposal" paragraph "Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of unused pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance." with the following paragraph:

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of unused pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
 - e. On the left panel, expand the sentence to "Wear protective clothing, such as gloves, long sleeved cotton shirt, long pants, and hat" and "If swallowed drink promptly a large quantity of non-alcoholic, gelatin solution, or water. Avoid alcohol, do not induce vomiting."
5. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. Any existing stock within your possession or control must be restickered to bear labeling approved as part of your conditional registration; all new production must also bear such a label.

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A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. In order to be acceptable, your label must bear the changes listed at item 4 above.

Precautionary Statements

DANGER

Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals

Corrosive. Causes skin burns and eye irritation. Harmful if absorbed through skin or inhaled. Do not get on skin, clothing or in eyes. May be a dermal sensitizer. Wear a face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Use in a well-ventilated area. Practical Treatment

Use artificial respiration if breathing has stopped. Get medical attention if swallowed. Do not induce vomiting. This product contains petroleum distillate. Get medical attention if in eyes, immediately flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not allow chips and dust generated during paint removal to enter water. Dispose of paint debris in an approved landfill.
