ALL WEATHER Clear Wood Preservative Finish is a transparent, water repellent exterior finish that highlights the beauty of wood's natural grain and texture without adding color. Water beads up and runs off its superior deep penetrating water repellent finish before it can do damage. Its wood preserving formula helps protect wood from rot, decay and mildew. Won't crack, peel or blister. Exceeds the Federal Specification TT-W-572B, Paragraph 3.7 for water repellency.

- OUSES: ALL-WEATHER Clear Wood Preservative Finish is recommended for above ground use on exterior bare wood shingles, shakes, beams, timbers, clapboards, smooth or rough-sawn wood siding, wood fences, decks, old weathered wood or any other porous exterior wood surface. Not recommended for interior use, hardboard surfaces or where any portion of the treated wood will be below ground.
- ° GENERAL SURFACE PREPARATION: All wood surfaces must be clean, sound, dry and free of dirt, dust, oil, soot or other foreign matter. Remove mildew by washing with 16 oz. liquid household bleach and 2 oz. non-ammoniated liquid detergent per gallon of water. Rinse well and let dry.
- ° TINTING: Not recommended.
- ° SPREADING RATE: Apply at 150 to 300 sq. ft. per gallon, depending on surface condition and wood porosity.
- APPLICATION: Mix well before use and stir frequently while using. Do not thin. Apply with a natural bristle brush for best results. Can also be sprayed using a low pressure, coarse spray. Roll application should be limited to rough surfaces using a long nap roller. One coat is sufficient. Can be applied over a penetrating semi-transparent stain (non-film forming) if desired. Cut and machine wood prior to treatment, if possible. If not, liberally apply two coats of preservative to all joints, cracks, cut-ends, holes or other openings. Do not apply to primed, previously painted or other sealed surfaces. Product must soak into the wood to be effective. Test a small area. If it soaks in, product can be applied.
- ORYING TIME: At 77°F and 50% R.H. dries to touch in four hours. Low temperature or high humidity increases this time.
- * RECOATABILITY: If a stain topcoat is desired, allow to dry overnight before application. ALL WEATHER Alkyd Stains can be used. If a latex stain or paint is desired, apply ALL WEATHER Alkyd Primer first or allow to weather at least 6 months. The strong water repellency properties of this product may impair topcoat (particularly latex type) adhesion. Adhesion should be tested first.
