Its wood preserving formula helps protect wood from rot, decay, and mildew. Won't crack, peel or blister. Exceeds the Federal Specification TT-W-572B, Paragraph 3.7, for water repellency.

- " USES: ALL-WEATHER Weathering Stain is recommended for exterior horizontal and vertical wood siding, clapboards, shingles, shakes, beams, fences, rough sawn lumber, or any other porous wood surface. Its tough alkyd binder provides a durable finish for all types of exterior wood decking, floors, porches and patios (use one coat only on these surfaces and brushed or abraded plywood). Not recommended for interior use, hardboard surfaces, or over any previously painted, sealed or nonporous surfaces.
