The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

As new labels are prepared, make the following changes:

- 1. Delete "etc" from the list of vegetables. (The claim for fruits is not acceptable since you have no directions for fruits on the label.)
- 2. Delete May be used xxx around humans and pets xxx from the statement May be used indoors, outdoors, in homes, restaurants, greenhouses, offices, schools xxx year-round. This can be construed as a safety claim and is inconsistent with the reference to removing aquaria before spraying.

Refer to the enclosed sample label for format issues.

The label marked FOR FRUITS AND VEGETABLES is not acceptable as there are no fruits listed.

The 355 ml label is unacceptable because you include the terms - Biodegradable - Non-Aerosol and Contains No Propellants. These are considered safety claims.
