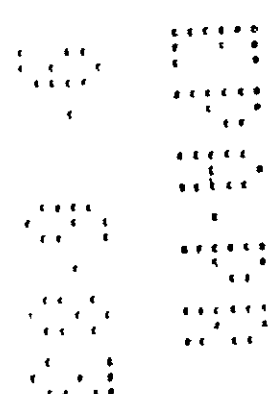

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (continued)

CITRUS-Citrus Thrips:

Air Application- Use 6-10 lbs. per acre in 10-25 gal. water. Add 8-18 lbs. sugar per acre as bait. Fly every row. Screen size should be 20 mesh or larger.

Ground Application- Use 6-10 lbs. per acre in 20 to 100 gals. water. Add 8-18 lbs. sugar per acre as bait. Screen size should be 20 mesh or larger.

SPECIMEN

APPLES-Codling Moth:

Use 8-10 lbs. _____ in 100 gals. water. Apply at 10 to 14 day intervals as required, with first application at petal fall. For later infestations, apply at 10 to 14 day intervals as required. Spray tree thoroughly to give complete coverage. Screen size should be 20 mesh or larger.

CORN-European Corn Borer:

Use 30 to 40 lbs. per acre as a dust. Apply at 5 day intervals as necessary, beginning when borers start gatching or feeding. Screen size should be 20 mesh or larger.
