

**Precautionary Statements  
Hazards to Humans and domestic animals**

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, or plain water, and these are available, then drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing manually or mechanically may be needed.

**DANGER**

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds or public water.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

- Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
- Open dumping is prohibited.
- Do not reuse empty container.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL**

Pesticide containers that cannot be reused or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill, or used for construction or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL**

This chemical and water should be placed in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place.

**GENERAL**

Consult federal, state or local regulatory authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**Initial Application:** To a cleaned pool add one gallon to 47,500 gallons of water, or ratio thereof.

**Maintenance Dose:** Use one quart per 47,500 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

**Booster Dose:** Immediately after every rain add one quart per 47,500 gallons of water as above.

**Important:** Follow above directions without fail, even when pool is not used. Algae growth must be fought at all times.

**Pool-side surfaces:** After cleaning surfaces, use one oz. to 3 1/2 gallons of water for sanitizing or one oz. to 1 3/4 gallons of water for disinfecting.

**ALGAE-GO** algaecide is efficient, economical and stable in use dilution.

**ALGAE-GO** is compatible with all chemicals used in pool water and will not damage tile, concrete, metal or plastics.
