DESCRIPTION.

Active Swine Confinement Pen Cleaner & Disinfectant Against Odor Causing Bacteria attacks and removes organic and other waste materials from aluminum, concrete and wood confinement pen surfaces. It is a blended combination of detergents, emulsifying, surface-acting and mineral electrolyte chemicals. There are no toxic fumes and the runoff will not affect sewage systems, and is fully biodegradable.

1. Remove all animals and feed from premises to be cleaned.
2. Wash all water and manure from floor, walls and surfaces of troughs, pens, crates, chutes & other facilities and fixtures. Rinse out or hosed by at least 100.
3. Apply product with tank and other feeding and watering devices.
4. Mix product with water with part cleaner. A solution of 1:1 with total surface using plastic fibred nozzle or stainless steel pressure sprayer. Allow solution to remain on the surface for 10 minutes.
5. Rinse with clean water. Residue is ca. 100 ppm.
6. Wash all equipment, tools and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals as well as the hands of persons handling the product.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Directions for Cleaning and Disinfecting Against Odor Causing Bacteria:

- Remove all animals and feed from premises to be cleaned.
- Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls and surfaces of barns, pens, stalls, chutes and other facilities occupied or traversed by animals. Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances.
- Mix 4 parts water with 1 part Cleaner and Disinfectant and apply to all surfaces using a plastic fibered brush or a stainless steel pressure sprayer. Allow disinfectant to work on the surface for 10 minutes, and rinse with as much water pressure as is available. 400 PSI is ideal.
- Immerse all halters, ropes and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals, as well as forks, shovels and scrapers used for removing litter and manure.
- Ventilate buildings and other closed spaces. Do not house animals or employ equipment until cleaner has been absorbed or dried.
- Thoroughly scrub and clean feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers with detergent. Rinse with potable water before reuse. Rinse as often as necessary.
- Each gallon of diluted solution will cover approximately 1000 square feet.
