Dear Ms. Vercek:

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with comments.

Proposed Amendment:

- Revised labeling per PR Notice 2001-1

Label Comments

1. Revise the precautionary statement subheading to read:

Precautionary Statement
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
Danger

Note that the precautionary statement subheading must be placed above the Precautionary Statement.

2. The child signal word Danger and the Keep Out of Reach of Children statement must be placed below the ingredient statement.

3. Add the following Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) language to the label:

Personal Protective Equipment

Applicators and other handlers must wear:

- coveralls, over long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- socks and chemical resistant foot wear;
- goggles or face shields,
- chemical resistant gloves (such as barrier laminate, butyl rubber, nitrile rubber, neoprene rubber, polyvinyl chloride, viton).

For mixing/loading: Wear a chemical resistant apron.

4. The following User Safety Requirements and Recommendations must be added to the label:

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions exist for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

User Safety Recommendations


"Users must wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Users must remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then was thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Users must remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly."
