Your submission involving a request for an alternate source of supply for the subject formulation and corresponding revised product labeling, has completed review. Please note the following.

1. The proposed alternate source of active ingredient, Nipacide BCP (EPA Registration No. 49403-2), is acceptable for use in the subject formulation.

2. The revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) enclosed with this submission reflecting the alternate source agrees with the product label and is acceptable.

3. The revised product labeling submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Five copies of the finished, printed labeling which incorporates these comments must be submitted before releasing the product for shipment.

a. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment heading to read: "STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID)".

b. Revise the "If Swallowed" instructions in the Statement Of Practical Treatment to read: "Promptly drink large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately. Avoid alcohol. Do not attempt to give fluids to an unconscious person."

c. Revise the "If On Skin" instructions in the Statement Of Practical Treatment to read: "Wash with plenty of soap and water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists."

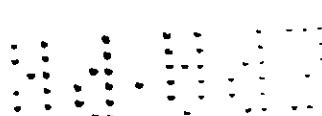
