DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Only for formulation as a preservative against bacteria or disinfectant for the following uses: (1) Only for formulation into microbiocide for the following use(s): industrial adhesives, general preservatives for leather, paper products*, joint cements, textiles*, fibers and cordage*, metalworking (cutting) fluids, industrial coatings* and resin*/latex/polymer* emulsions.

- (2) General hard surface disinfectant uses.
- (3) Uses for which U.S. EPA has accepted data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration.
- (4) Uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with US EPA requirements. Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registrations for their own formulated products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
