

not occur within 5 to 10 minutes, administer second dose. If syrup of ipecac is not available, induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear.

Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.

In case of poisoning: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Have patient lie down and keep quiet.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: No specific antidote is available. Treat symptomatically.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This pesticide is toxic to estuarine invertebrates. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing

Millwork: Window frames, wood doors, door frames.

<u>Wood Stains (Preservative Incorporation):</u> Wood siding, lumber, plywood, particleboard, wood decks, wood furniture (outdoor).

Sapstain: Fresh-cut lumber

ALL THE ABOVE USES ARE NON-SOIL CONTACT, NON-FUMIGANT TREATMENTS

<u>Plastics (PVC or Polvurethane)</u>: Non-food contact surfaces: Shower curtains, tarpaulins, sun umbrellas Plastics Products (preservative/additive incorporation)

#### RESTRICTIONS

Do not package PREVENTOL A8 Technical in metal containers.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.
