FIRST AID:

DOSAGES OF PREVENTOL OF 45 BASED ON WEIGHT OF THE FORMULATED SLURRY:

Calcium carbonate slurry: 0.03--0.06% (3-6 lbs of product per 10,000 lbs of slurry)
Talcum slurry: 0.03--0.06% (3-6 lbs of product per 10,000 lbs of slurry)
Titanium oxide slurry: 0.03--0.06% (3-6 lbs of product per 10,000 lbs of slurry)

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT: Applicators and other handlers must wear: coveralls, over long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks and chemical resistant footwear, goggles or face shields, chemical resistant gloves (such as barrier laminate, butyl rubber, nitrile rubber, neoprene rubber, polyvinyl chloride, vitron). For mixing/loading wear a chemical resistant apron.

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions exist for washables, used detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.
