On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided:

1. You will submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. You submit a product specific testing protocols for efficacy testing against mosquitoes, ticks, biting midges, fleas, chiggers, and biting flies (Tabanids) by April 30, 2007. Product specific efficacy data must be submitted within 24 months and no later than November 30, 2008.
3. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:
 - a) Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Reg. No.39967-50".
 - b) Change the heading entitled "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" to read "Hazards to Humans". Revise the language in this section to read as follows: "Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling, returning indoors, and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Discontinue use and consult a doctor if irritation or rash occurs."

c) Revise the "First Aid Statement" as follows:

"If in eyes:

- Hold eye open and rinse gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first five minutes, then continue rinsing.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice."

If swallowed:

- Call a physician or poison control center immediately for treatment advice.
- Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a Poison Control Center or a doctor.
- Do not give anything to an unconscious person."

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-xxx-xxxx for emergency medical information.

d) Revise the "Directions for Use"

1. Add the following statements:

- Repels insects and ticks for up to eight hours.
- Reapply every 8 hours. Do not exceed two applications per day.
- Do not spray directly on face.
- Avoid contact with lips, cuts, wounds, or irritated skin.
- Do not apply to excessively sunburned skin.
- Do not apply under clothing.
- Apply sparingly around ears.

2. Remove:

- "Reapply every 6 to 8 hours."
- "This product is not intended for use on young children."
- "New Generation insect repellent"
- "Feels good on skin"

e) Revise the disposal directions in the Storage and Disposal section to be consistent with PR Notice 2001-6 as follows:

"If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or [toll free number] for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain. "


g). Change the name of "Environmental Hazards" to "Physical Hazards".

- 4. Submit the results of a one year storage stability (830.6317) and corrosion characteristics (830.6320) to the Agency on completion. It is recommended that the observations be made at 0,3,6,9, & 12 month intervals. Submit the results of a study corresponding to guideline 830.6314 (oxidation-reduction). The results must be submitted in a hard copy and an electronic format is also requested.
- 5. The basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated November 30, 2006 is acceptable and is the CSF of record.
- 6. The acute toxicity profile is as follows:

Dermal Sensitization	Negative – not a dermal sensitizer

- 7. Please submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
