
Subject: Fast Track Amendment
KBR 3023 Insect Repellent Cream
EPA Reg. No. 39967-50
Submissions dated April 15, 2009

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under Section (3)(c)(7) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided you:

1. Remove "Effective protection against West Nile virus" from the label.
2. Revise: "Apply on face by first spreading small amounts in palms of hands and spreading on face and neck." to "Apply on face by first spreading small amounts in palms of hands and spreading on face and neck, avoiding your eyes."
3. For consistency with other registered picaridin products add: "When using on children, apply to your hands and then apply it to the child. Do not apply to their hands. To apply to a child's face and neck, apply the product into your hands and apply to the child. Take care to avoid mouth and eyes and apply sparingly around ears. Do not allow children to handle the product."
4. Remove: "DEET FREE"
5. Remove: "Like a screen porch in a bottle."
6. Remove: "Proven as effective as DEET."
7. Remove: "The bites stop here."
