The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable. The Agency approves: the addition of stable flies, black flies and ticks; removal of fleas; and an increase in the protection times for mosquitoes and ticks to 14 hours based on recently accepted studies that were reviewed by OPP and HSRB.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

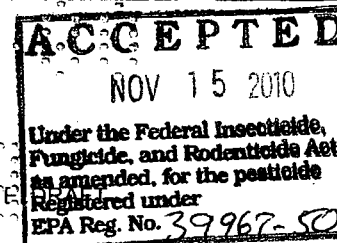
STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place out of the reach of children. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame.
