After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR § 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to your company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by EPA. Follow these guidelines when applying KBR 3023 All-Family Insect Repellent Spray:

- Hold 4 to 6 inches from skin while spraying, keeping nozzle pointed away from face. Slightly moisten skin with a slow sweeping motion.
- Excessive amounts or frequent reapplication is unnecessary.
- Do not exceed two applications per day.
- Apply on face by first spraying small amounts in palms of hands and spreading on face and neck, avoiding your eyes.
- Do not apply to the hands of small children.
- When using on children, apply to your hands and then apply it to the child. Do not apply to their hands. To apply to a child's face and neck, spray the product into your hands and apply to the child. Take care to avoid mouth and eyes and apply sparingly around ears. Do not allow children to handle the product.
- Do not spray directly on face.
- Avoid contact with lips, cuts, wounds, or irritated skin.
- Do not apply to excessively sunburned skin.
- Do not apply under clothing.
- Apply sparingly around ears.
